1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

Lithuanian Yachting Union (LYU)

2. RULES

2.1. The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS 2017-2020)

2.2. No national prescriptions will apply.

2.3. The following rules will also apply:

2.3.1. IMS Rules

2.3.2. ORC Rating Systems Rules

2.3.3. WS Offshore Special Regulations, category 4 with following exceptions:

4.23.1.- 3 red hand flares are mandatory;

4.26. - recommended;

5.01.1. a) - 100N buoyancy is allowed instead of 150N buoyancy;

5.01.1. c) – recommended.

2.4. Between 22:00 and 05:00 the RRS Part 2 in applicable parts shall be replaced by the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea (IRPCAS) or Lithuanian Republic government right-of-way rules and all boats shall show the required navigational lights. [DP]*

2.5. Under RRS 87, ORC Rule 206 is changed as follows: a) All sails shall have been measured and stamped by an ORC measurer. b) The maximum number of sails shall be as defined in ORC Rule 206 with one additional mainsail allowed. The second mainsail shall have a minimum of one set of reef points. The mainsails may be interchangeable. c) With the exception of the second mainsail all sails shall be aboard while racing. d) Sails damaged during the series may be repaired. Sails beyond repair may be replaced with permission of the Technical Committee.

2.6 Minimum crew weight as defined in ORC Rules 102.3 and 200.1(b) shall apply.

2.7. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text shall prevail.

3. ADVERTISING

3.1. The WS regulation 20 - Advertising Code shall apply.

3.2. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority. [DP]*

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1. The person in charge onboard shall produce evidence of membership in his/her National Authority or in one of its affiliated organization and be at least 18 years old.

4.2. The Regatta is open to all boats with a valid ORC Club or ORC International certificate dated no later than 25.05.2018.

5. CLASSES

ORC Boats will be divided in Classes according to the CDL (Class Division Length) as follows:

ORC A CDL limits will be announced after registration closed

ORC B CDL limits will be announced after registration closed

ORC C $8,0 \geq CDL \geq 6,5$

A and B classes will be divided into 2 equal groups after registration closed.

To assign an Lithuanian ORC Champion title in classes A and B the number of boats shall be not less than 6 (six). The Organizing Authority

has the right to group two

ORC classes if the minimum numbers are not met. In this case, only one Championship title will be assigned to the combined classes.

6. ENTRIES AND ENTRY FEE

6.1 Eligible boats may enter by filling in the online registration form at www.regatos.lt

6.2 The non-refundable entry fees are as follows:

6.3 A boat is considered to be pre-registered if the following documents are received before 06.06.2018.

- a) Completed and signed official entry form;
- b) Current ORC International or ORC Club Certificate
- c) Entry fee payment confirmation;

6.4 The organizer is not responsible for any costs incurred by the non-acceptance of a boat's registration.

6.5. Entry fee shall be paid to the Lithuanian Yachting Union account as onetime payment where the name of event "ORC Championship 2018" and name of the participating boat shall be stated.

7. REGISTRATION

7.1 Class ORC A, B and C Owner or Skipper must personally register in the Race Office located in „Castle Harbour“ marina from 15:00, 07.06.2018. until 20:00, 07.06.2018. or from 8:00 until 9:30 08 06 2018.

7.2 The following documents shall be presented at registration:

- a) Valid ORC International or ORC Club certificate issued before 25.05.2018.;
- b) Valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of 1 000 000€;
- c) Crew list with name, surname and weight for each crew member;
- d) Contact phone number both on boat and land, including the name of contact person;
- e) Liability acceptance form (PK4-18), duly filled out and signed;
- f) Sails declaration, with a list of all identifiable sails which will be used during the event. This changes RRS 78.2.

7.3 Measurement protests by the boats shall be accepted up to one hour after the posting of the final ratings.

7.4 Crew lists may be amended up to 10:00 on 08.06.2018. by filling a new form showing the changes. After this time, changes in crew may be made only with the written permission of the Protest Committee.

8. SCHEDULE

8.1 Thursday, 07.06.2018. – 15:00-20:00 Registration and measurement in Castle Harbour marina.

Friday, 08.06.2018. – 8:00-9:30 Registration and measurement in Castle Harbour marina

12:00 offshore race

Saturday, 09.06.2018. – up to 4 inshore races

Sunday, 10.06.2018. – up to 2 inshore races

On the last day no races are scheduled after 15:00.

- a) One offshore race approximately 6-8 hours duration for the slowest boat. The scoring coefficient shall be 1,4. Offshore race may be re-scheduled when required by weather conditions.
- b) Inshore races shall be of approximately 1- 1,5 hours duration, and shall have a scoring coefficient of 1.0.

8.2 Seven races are scheduled including offshore race and six inshore races. Inshore races will be windward/leeward races.

8.3 The championship is valid if at least 2 inshore races and offshore race are completed. One discard will be allowed if 4 inshore races are completed and 2 discards if 6 inshore races are completed. The discard may be any inshore race. The offshore race may not be discarded.

9. MEASUREMENT

Each boat shall be available for the measurement inspection from 15:00 until 20:00, 07.06.2018 or from 8:00 until 9:30, 08.06.2018. Measurement and rules compliance inspections will be carried out throughout the championship before or after each race with emphasis on boats well placed in the scoring. The inspection will also include freeboards whenever possible.

10. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available for each entrant at completion of the registration formalities.

11. SCORING

11.1 For ORC Classes windward/leeward race results will be determined by Time On Time Triple Number scoring system.

11.2 For ORC Classes offshore race results will be determined by Time On Time Offshore Single Number scoring system.

11.3 The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A. Points will be multiplied by the appropriate scoring coefficient.

12. PROTEST COMMITTEE

A Protest Committee will be appointed according to RRS 91(a).

13. MOORINGS

Participating boats will have moorings free of charge in Castle Harbour marina (Pilies g. 4, LT-91240, Klaipėda) for the period 07-10.06.2018.

14. MEDIA RIGHTS

Competitors, owners and their guests give absolute right and permission to the Organizing Authority for any photography and video footage taken of persons and boats during the event, to be published and/or broadcast in any media, including but not limited to TV advertisements, whatsoever for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information.

15. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except when communicating with the Race Committee, a boat while racing, shall not transmit or receive communication of any information not publicly available to all boats participating. The Race Committee uses VHF channel 68.

16. PRIZES

16.1 Championship medals issued by the Lithuanian Yachting Union will be distributed to the first three boats in each class if at least 6 boats are competing in that class. The number of medals awarded to each boat equals the number of persons sailing on that boat at the same time.

16.2 Other prizes and trophies will be awarded at the discretion of the organizers. All medals and prizes will be awarded at the Prize Giving Ceremony and all participants are expected to participate in that ceremony.

17. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

All those taking part in the regatta do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Organizing Authority, ORC and any other party involved in the organization of the Lithuanian ORC Championship 2018 disclaim any and all responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and materials, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the event. Each boat owner or his representative accepts these terms by signing entry form. The attention of competitors is drawn to World Sailing Part 1 Fundamental Rule 4: A boat is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing.

18. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party insurance with a minimum cover of 1 000 000€ per event. Regardless, it is the responsibility of the owners to hold adequate insurance cover for Tort Liability and Third Party Insurance (Property and Persons). Competitor can purchase the insurance at the Race Office.
